Monthly Class Tuition Policies:

Financial Obligations due at Registration (both are NON-REFUNDABLE):

Membership Fee: \$25 per student Last month tuition (May 2020)

Tuition at CDE is based on 10-month calendar beginning on August 5th and ending on May 15th. Tuition can be paid monthly or in full at time of registration. Tuition is not based on a four-classes-per-month rate but rather on the annual cost divided into 10 payments.

Pay the full year's tuition at registration and receive a 5% discount. Payment must be made by August 7, 2019.

We accept VISA, MasterCard, AMEX or Discover and all monthly tuition will be charged via AUTO-PAY. Upon enrollment, the credit card on file will be charged the membership fee and May 2020 tuition. You will receive a confirmation email detailing your exact amounts.

Monthly tuition will be processed on the 7th of each month. You are required to keep a current card on file in your portal. If you prefer a different form of payment (cash, check) your payment must be received prior to the automatic charge date of the 7th. If not received by the 7th, your required card on file will be charged the amount outstanding. ***Overdue fees will accrue a late fee of \$20 after the 7th. If fees remain unpaid at the end of the month, students will not be permitted to participate in their lessons.

Tuition is not prorated for absences or studio closures. Students are encouraged to attend makeup classes for absences. A makeup google form is available on our website (https://www.cdegarner.com/registration/)

Membership Fees and last month tuition, May 2020, are NON-REFUNDABLE.

Total tuition is determined by the total amount of time your dancer receives instruction per week. To determine family tuition, total each individual's tuition, add the amounts together then take the sibling discount. Sibling Discount: 10% off for 2nd student; 15% off for 3rd student. (example: Child 1 takes 2 hours: \$97, Child 2 takes 1hr: \$65 minus 10%, Child 3 takes 45 min: \$58 minus 15%. Total is \$200.80 per month.)

Showcase:

All CDE members registered in performance classes are invited to participate in the end-of-year showcase. If choosing NOT to participate in the showcase, please notify the office prior to September 6. Costume deposits (\$40 per costume) will be due in September and balances (\$25, \$35,or \$45) due in November. Showcase fee is \$20 per family and ticket price will be approximately \$14. Fees help with the cost of the showcase venue for rehearsal and show, props, lighting, audio, and stage crew.

Withdrawal Policy

Written notification is required for all class withdrawals (email is acceptable). Costume payments and May 2020 tuition are NON-REFUNDABLE.



Christy's DancExplosion (CDE) uses a sliding scale to calculate tuition rates. Add up the amount of time per week of instruction, then slide over and find the rate of tuition per month.
